## An Introduction to School Meals

The National School Lunch & Breakfast Program is a federally funded program providing nutritionally balanced meals to children. The USDA administers the program at the federal level. School districts that choose to participate in the program receive financial assistance for each meal they serve. In return, they must serve meals that meet federal nutritional requirements and offer free or reduced priced meals to eligible children.

### Do you Qualify for Free or Reduced Priced Meals?

Based on your household income, your children could qualify for free or reduced priced meals at school! To find out if you qualify, you must fill out a National School Lunch & Breakfast Program Application.

## Did You Know?

If you qualify for reduced priced lunch you only pay \$0.30 per meal at breakfast or \$0.40 per meal at lunch! That's a savings of \$469.05 at the elementary level and \$495.60 at the middle and high school level! And if you qualify for free lunches, you won't pay anything at all!

### Meal Payment Options

Students have the opportunity to pre-pay for the meals they purchase from our cafeterias. Parents can send cash or a check, payable to OFSD, with their child to school. Children may turn in the cash or check into the cafeteria drop box outside the cafeteria. The money received will be placed in your child's dining account and as meals and other food items are purchased, the cost will be appropriately deducted.
